STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible to enter any B&DLGA event, players must hold a current Australian Women's Handicap, and be prepared to provide evidence of handicap on request.
- RULES:** The rules of golf, the local rules of the clubs at which the event is being played, and any supplementary local rules shall be the rules in play during the Tournament.
- DRESS REGULATIONS:** The dress regulations of the venue club will apply for players and their caddies. It is the responsibility of the player to ascertain dress regulations for the venue club.
- ENTRIES:** Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by an Entry Fee. Entry Fees are not refundable after the competition has closed. *Exceptions. 1. If nominations exceed the capacity of the venue, a ballot will be conducted. 2. Minimum number of entries required for the event to be held.* Acceptance of post entries is at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Substitute players will not be accepted in single event, but may be accepted in Foursomes or Team events. *(See Specific Conditions of Play)*
- TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make all arrangements, to fix and/or alter starting times and to make any variations to the Conditions of Play. The Committee reserves the right to change the handicap limits or to alter the number of Divisions in any event, or, in the case of insufficient entries, to cancel the event. The Committee also reserves the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give reasons for such refusal.
- TIES:** Ties will be decided by GA default method of matching cards. (Rule 33-6 & Appendix 1 Part C 11c). It will on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes, if tie still exists calculate over last six, last three and finally hole by hole from the 18th hole. For a multiple tee start the last nine holes is considered to be 10-18 etc. *Exception: Junior & District Championships – see Specific Conditions of Play*
- PACE OF PLAY:** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. In the absence of mitigating circumstances, players must maintain their place in the field, directly behind the group in front.
- DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY:** A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. Infringement of this condition may mean disqualification. The consumption of alcohol by players and caddies on the course during a stipulated round is strictly prohibited. The penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- MOBILE PHONES:** Mobile Phones must be turned off or in the Mute Mode AT ALL TIMES while on course. Use of mobile phones on course (emergencies excepted) is a serious breach of etiquette. (Rule 33-7). Disqualification.
- PROTESTS:** All disputes shall be settled by the B&DLGA Match Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES:** These Devices are not permitted in B&DLGA events.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: *(See also Standard Conditions of Play)*

- ELIGIBILITY:** In the open Championships players must be members of a club affiliated with Golf Australia. In the closed event, the players HOME club must be affiliated with B&DLGA.
- VETERANS:** B&DLGA Veterans' age requirements are Veterans 55-64 and Senior Veterans 65 and over. Players may be requested to provide proof of age.
- PRACTICE:** Players may practice on the competition course on the days in between each 18 holes. i.e Saturday/Sunday.
- TIES:** A tie in the 36 Hole gross events shall be decided by a SUDDEN DEATH play-off on hole/s to be decided by the B&DLGA on the day of play. All other ties shall be decided by the R&A method of matching cards as details in the Standard Conditions of Play.
- MOTORISED TRANSPORT IS NOT ALLOWED IN CHAMPIONSHIP (GROSS) EVENTS EXCEPT FOR DISABILITY AS DEFINED IN THE GQ GENERAL CONDITIONS.** (Exception: Players 65 years and over may use motorised transport in all events and be prepared to provide proof of age if requested)
- HANDICAPS:** The handicap used on the first day will be the handicap used on the second day for all events. No handicap changes apply, irrespective of scores.
- TROPHIES:** A player may win only one major trophy. Perpetual Trophies excluded. If no entries are received for the Open Event, only the Closed Event trophy will be presented. The ball rundown is exclusive of trophy winners.
