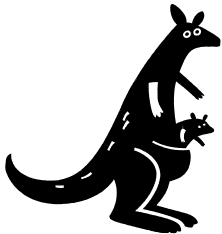

## **2011 COUNTRY DAY ROSEWOOD GOLF CLUB - FRIDAY 9th SEPTEMBER 2011 CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

### **STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible to enter any B&DLGA event, players must hold a current Australian Women's Handicap, and be prepared to provide evidence of handicap on request.
2. **RULES:** The rules of golf, the local rules of the clubs at which the event is being played, and any supplementary local rules shall be the rules in play during the Tournament.
3. **DRESS REGULATIONS:** The dress regulations of the venue club will apply for players and their caddies. It is the responsibility of the player to ascertain dress regulations for the venue club.
4. **ENTRIES:** Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by an Entry Fee. Entry Fees are not refundable after the competition has closed. *Exceptions: 1. If nominations exceed the capacity of the venue, a ballot will be conducted. 2. Minimum number of entries required for the event to be held. Acceptance of post entries is at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Substitute players will not be accepted in single event, but may be accepted in Foursomes or Team events. (See Specific Conditions of Play)*
5. **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make all arrangements, to fix and/or alter starting times and to make any variations to the Conditions of Play. The Committee reserves the right to change the handicap limits or to alter the number of Divisions in any event, or, in the case of insufficient entries, to cancel the event. The Committee also reserves the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give reasons for such refusal.
6. **TIES:** Ties will be decided by GA default method of matching cards. (Rule 33-6 & Appendix 1 Part C 11c). It will on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes, if tie still exists calculate over last six, last three and finally hole by hole from the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. For a multiple tee start the last nine holes is considered to be 10-18 etc. *Exception: Junior & District Championships – see Specific Conditions of Play*
7. **PACE OF PLAY:** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. In the absence of mitigating circumstances, players must maintain their place in the field, directly behind the group in front.
8. **DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY:** A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. Infringement of this condition may mean disqualification. The consumption of alcohol by players and caddies on the course during a stipulated round is strictly prohibited. The penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
9. **MOBILE PHONES:** Mobile Phones must be turned off or in the Mute Mode AT ALL TIMES while on course. Use of mobile phones on course (emergencies excepted) is a serious breach of etiquette. (Rule 33-7). Disqualification.
10. **PROTESTS:** All disputes shall be settled by the B&DLGA Match Committee, whose decision shall be final.
11. **DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES:** These Devices are not permitted in B&DLGA events.

### **SPECIFIC CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR COUNTRY DAY:** *(See also Standard Conditions of Play)*

1. This is an Open Event. Entries will be accepted from Lady Members of Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia.
2. The event will be a Team Event consisting of three or four players. Players may enter as a Club Team and be eligible to win the Perpetual Team Trophy. Individuals may enter and be placed in a composite team,, however they will be able to win the Team Event but not the Perpetual Trophy.
3. The winners of the Perpetual Team Event trophy must be members of the same club.
4. **MOTORISED TRANSPORT IS ALLOWED.** Booking of buggies is the player's responsibility.
5. A player may win only one major trophy. Perpetual trophies excluded. The ball rundown is exclusive of trophy winners.

**1 score on holes 1/2/3 and 10/11/12,  
2 scores on holes 4/5/6 and 13/14/15  
3 scores on holes 7/8/9 and 16/17/18**

**FEE: \$15 per player - \$60 per Team
