2010 Joan Irving Memorial / B&DLGA Junior Championship

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. THE COMPETITION:

The Joan Irving Memorial Day / B&DLGA Junior Championship will be held over 18 holes Stroke Play on Sunday 23rd May 2010. The competition will be played in divisions dependant on the number of entries received.

- 2. COMPETITION COMMITTEE:** A Competition Committee, appointed by GNGF/B&DLGA, shall have sole management and control of the event. The Competition Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another date/venue, (c) vary any condition should they deem it advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore. The decisions of the Competition Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision, and any such decision shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Competition Committee.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1 The Joan Irving Memorial / B&DLGA Junior Championship is open to all female amateur golfers who have not attained the age of 18 years, as at 23rd May 2010, who possess Golf Australia Handicap or international equivalent and who are members of a golf club affiliated through their District Golf Association with Golf Queensland, or other State/National Associations.

3.2 Entries must be received at Greg Norman Golf Foundation, PO Box 50, RBH HERSTON QLD 4029 at 4pm on Friday 7th May, 2010. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Committee.

3.3 The prescribed nomination fee (\$27.50 – incl. GST) must accompany the Nomination Form at time of nomination. Faxed entries will only be accepted where the nomination fee is paid by credit card

3.4 Do not send cash in the mail - GNGF will not accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received.

3.5 Players must include their GolfLink number or attach a copy of the player's handicap history endorsed by a home clubs official.

3.6 Nominations are accepted at face value, on the basis that information contained therein is correct, and up to date. Should this subsequently be proven not to be the case, the committee reserves the right to deem any competitor ineligible – at any time prior to or during the Competition.

3.7 Players will play off their handicap as at the 23rd May 2010.

3.8 Once the draw is published there will be no refund of entry fees to players who withdraw from the event.

3.9 B&DLGA Junior Championship ties will be decided by a sudden death play off over hole/s to be decided by the Tournament Committee. In the event of a tie for the Joan Irving Memorial the winners will be determined by use of the Australian Countback System, including overall Champion.

PUBLICITY: The Committee arranges publicity before, during and/or after this Competition. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them, and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet).

PRIVACY: The Committee may retain the personal details (i.e. name, address, handicap) of entrants in this Competition on its records.

DRESS REGULATIONS: It is a requirement of this tournament that all players must comply with the dress regulations of the host club.

PRACTICE: The provision of practice rounds will be by arrangement with the host club, under whatever terms and conditions they determine.

RULES: The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R & A Rules Limited will apply and any supplementary Local Rules as are approved by the Competition Committee.

COURSE MARKERS: During practice or during the Competition a player shall not place on the course, or cause to be placed on the course, any artificial marker or other device designed to indicate course measurements. A player in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.

DRAW AND STARTING TIMES: A draw will be published on the GNGF/B&DLGA websites. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Competition Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "The Player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Competition that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving

the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole, instead of disqualification.

BALL: It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Competition to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A and/or USGA Approved Lists. Copies of these lists are available from www.randa.org.
Penalty: Disqualification.

USE OF MOTORISED VEHICLES: During any round of the tournament, competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle unless authorised by the Competition Committee.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CONDITION: In the absence of an exemption – 2 strokes at each hole at which a breach of this condition occurred; maximum penalty per round – 4 strokes.

MEASURING DEVICES: Distance Measuring devices are not permitted in either of these events.

MOBILE PHONES: The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during the play of any competition round is prohibited. Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disqualification.

PACE OF PLAY: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. To assist players and the Committee, a pace of play schedule will be published, and players will be bound by this schedule and the penalties detailed therein.

DRUG TESTING: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Doping Policy - endorsed by Golf Queensland. Any competitor infringing this condition, or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.

SMOKING AND ALCOHOL: Smoking and/or the consumption of alcohol by competitors is not permitted.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing with the Competition Committee no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the player's round.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be presented after the completion of play. **Note: A player may win only one Trophy**
